• BOY	Beginning of Year
• CCMR	College, Career and Military Readinesspreparing students for life after graduation. It is made up of curriculum, resources, programs and activities that help students have the tools they need to enter college or the workforce and begin a career. The Texas Education Agency (TEA) has defined a set of indicators that students can earn to be considered college, career or military ready. Students who meet one of these CCMR indicators are considered "CCMR-met." CCMR readiness indicators include: • Meet Criteria on Advanced Placement (AP) Examination. • Meet Criteria of 4 or higher on the International Baccalaureate (IB) exam. • Meet TSI Criteria via SAT, ACT, TSI-A, or College Prep Course in English and Math • Earn Dual Course Credits • Earn an Associate Degree • Complete an OnRamps Dual Enrollment Course • Earn an Industry-Based Certification • Graduate with Completed Individualized Education Program (IEP) and Workforce Readiness. • Enlist in the Armed Forces. • Graduate Under an Advanced Diploma Plan and be Identified as a Current Special Education Student. • Earn a Level I or Level II Certificate. CCMR is also a component of a school district's Accountability Rating.

• FTE	Full-Time Equivalents measure the extent to which a person (or responsibility) occupies a full-time position and are calculated for each staff member reported through PEIMS. FTE values are used in various staff reports as well as input to the Budget and Actual financial allocation process.
• GOLD	Prekindergarten Progress Monitoring Instrument from the Commissioner's List of Approved Prekindergarten Instruments.

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mCLASS	Required beginning-of-year kindergarten reading instrument
• MOY	Middle of Year
• MTSS	Multi-Tiered Systems of Support- a framework that helps educational organizations align resources and initiatives to meet the needs of all students
• On Ramps	Provides authentic college distance learning in core subjects. Students can simultaneously gain high school and university credit for approved courses.
• PEIMS	Public Education Information Management System encompasses all data requested and received by TEA about public education, including student demographic and academic performance, personnel, financial, and organizational information.
• PFE	Parent and Family Engagement
• Rooms	a secure, two-way messaging tool that allows teachers to communicate with parents, guardians, and students within a school app.
• STAAR	State of Texas Assessments of Academic Readiness
• TIA	Teacher Incentive Allotment
