The ZCHS Boys Tennis team has the opportunity to travel to the Western Southern Open Tennis Tournament in Cincinnati, Ohio on August 9-10, 2025. They will be taking charter buses and will leave from the 875 Tennis Complex. The team will be staying overnight at Home2Suites in Cincinnati. Greg Schellhase has reviewed and approved their travel itinerary.

Transportation	Charter Bus
Parent Permission Obtained	The head coach will send an email to the parents and players with the details needed for the trip. Students are not required to attend; it is optional based on family decision.
Cost to Students/Families	Kings Island tickets, Western Southern Open tickets and hotel will be paid for by the families that are attending. The anticipated number of people going is 50 including parent chaperones so the approximate cost is \$250 per person.
About Supervision	Head Coach Earl Allen and assistant coaches will be chaperoning this trip.
Outline COVID Protocols	If a student or coach has any symptoms of COVID, they will not attend this event.
Trip Insurance Plan and Refund Procedure (if there is one)	All tickets are purchased by individuals, and they will bring their own spending money.
