

## **Play Up Policy/Procedure Comments:**

**Brainerd** – No Comments

**Elk River** – Contact Sports No Play Up (Except to fulfill the team ex: wrestling if we need a weight class) Will let 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders play up only if not cutting 9<sup>th</sup> graders and they will play at their skill level

**Farmington** – Unwritten – Only for Varsity

**Mahtomedi** – Completing a handbook with a proposed play up policy/procedure

**Mankato West** - Will let 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders play up only if not cutting 9<sup>th</sup> graders

**Monticello** – If we have participation issues we move them up to maintain a level of play and we use a promotional form if the Varsity Coach thinks they can complete at the varsity level or start on JV

**New Prague** – Discouraged but if the coach feels a player can compete at the Varsity level each case is determined on an individual basis

**Spring Lake Park** - Used to maintain levels of play ex: Girls Hockey

**St. Louis Park** – May play varsity if good enough and will let 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders play up only if not cutting 9<sup>th</sup> graders

**White Bear Lake** – Process: 1. WBLAHS coach and Activities Director discuss  
2. WBLAHS coach and parents discuss 3. WBLAHS coach and Middle School Principal discuss (eligibility form completed with MS Principal's signature) 4. WBLAHS coach secures parents signature and submits finalized form to the Activities Director for approval and signature
