Our Impact in Numbers

Who we are and what we do

We the ROE35 mentors, Skye Escatel and Selenia Arteaga, are currently on our second school year at MHS. Our role is to empower and support high school students in their personal and continued growth in school. We focus on monitoring our students' progress, attendance, and grades, as well as providing interventions to support and mentor our students' academic, social and behavioral concerns. In doing so, we help students come up with and achieve 4 SMART goals per school year (2 each semester)

2024-2025 data

- We served 63 students
- 19 students improved their attendance (from previous school year 2023-2024)
- 18 students improved their GPA (from previous school year 2023-2024)
- 93% achieved SMART goals first semester
- 97% achieved SMART goals second semester

Current 2025 - 2026 data

- We currently serve 80 students
- 88% achieved SMART goals first semester
- 12 goals focused on attendance
- 31 goals focused on social/emotional learning
- 88 goals focused on academics

Fun Facts

- 27 mentor program students were honored at the Academic Honors Assembly
- Weekly round table discussions amongst students and mentors took place this year. Topics included: healthy relationships and boundaries, building confidence and self esteem, goal setting and motivation, resume building and job interview prep, conflict resolution and problem-solving.
- There are roughly 20 students who come see their mentor everyday, multiple times a day
