**Background Information:**

- Each year an instructional calendar is developed to meet the teaching and learning needs of students and staff.
- School districts must provide 75,600 operational minutes to receive full ADA funding.

**Administrative Considerations:**

The administration considered the following when working through the calendar development process:

- Required 75,600 operational minutes
- Teacher contracted days
- Previous input from students, staff, and community
- State and district assessment days
- Surrounding districts' calendars, including Tarrant County College
- District start and end of school year
- Placement of professional development days
- Start and end days of major holiday breaks
- Parental custodial rights
