Report/Discussion Items

Strategic Plan Quarterly Board Update: Special Assistant Superintendent Monica McDaniel opened this item for discussion. This quarterly presentation focused on two specific projects (1) Systematize Blending Learning, (2) and Data Interoperability.

First, Mandy Hinojos, Blended Learning Coordinator, gave the board an update on our blended learning journey. She defined what it looks like in our district and the number of campuses that were piloting blended learning strategies. Campus visits and professional learning are a priority when it comes to implementing blended learning. We are currently working to determine campus readiness and hope to bring on 3 more campuses beginning in August. Our board was able to hear Nathalia, a 2nd grader at Pease, talk about the choices she gets to make on her own learning journey.

Second, Heather Potts, Director of Information Systems, provided an update on the Strategic Initiative of Attain Data Interoperability. Data Interoperability goal is to have a seamless and secure exchange of data between the different software systems. There are three main efforts to achieve this: establish Operational Data Storage using the Ed-Fi Format, implement Data Governance Teams on the campuses and the August 2022 roll out of School Status as a data visualization tool.
