

Review of Pilot ACT Exam June 11, 2019

ADE Five Year Assessment Plan

• In 2019-20 and 2020-21:

- All Sophomores will take a re-named AzMERIT test for Math and ELA. This new assessment will combine 9th and 10th grade content. (This is similar to the old AIMS test, but will not be required for graduation.)
- There will be no 11th grade AzMERIT test.
- Districts can administer an additional test (from the Menu of Assessments) at the high school level, but it is in addition to, not instead of, the re-named AzMERIT test.
- No changes are being made to elementary and middle school students.
- In 2020-21, a new statewide assessment will be field tested. It will be implemented in 2021-22.

• In 2021-22 and beyond:

- High school students will take an ASBE-approved 11th grade college entrance test, which will be considered the state assessment.
- Elementary and middle school students will take the new statewide assessment while the ASBE works to adopt a Menu of Assessments for these grades.







ACT Pilot Year

- AHS tested 8 times as many students over last year (from 26 to 215)
- CDO tested almost 4 times as many students over last year (from 100 to 380)
- IRHS tested more than double the number of students over last year (from 190 to 505)
- 111 SPED and 33 ELL students tested
- 368 Juniors receiving Free and Reduced Lunch (FRLP) benefits at our three high schools tested








