Meeting Agenda Item Notes

<u>Speech/Language Services</u> Educational speech/language therapists who are available to work 'face to face' in schools has become very rare. This means most schools now rely on 'teletherapy' (online). Although it seems not ideal, it is remarkably effective. We have been fortunate for the past few years to have both a 'face to face' therapist on our staff, as well as contracting with a teleservices company.

This spring, our 'face to face' therapist moved to Wisconsin with her family and we have been unable to hire a 'face to face' replacement. Therefore, on the consent agenda is a contract for us to contract for teleservices with a 2nd therapist. Thank you to Principal Riebel and Dr. Hanson who have spent much time interviewing and better understanding the questions of assessments, services, supervision and technology needs of online speech services. Parents who are accustomed to having a 'face to face' therapy services for their child will be informed of this change.

<u>Teaching Staff Changes</u> Also on the Consent Agenda is the resignation of three teachers – each of which is leaving the K-12 teaching profession. We wish each of them the best with their new endeavors and thank them for their work with our students and school district. There is no doubt we will have a larger than typical group of new teachers on our staff this fall!

We are planning a longer/larger than typical 'new teacher in-service' activities and we are excited to help them get to know each other, as well as having our veteran teachers embrace their important role of mentoring and support! Stay tuned for more details on these plans. Thank you again, to the principals for their commitment in recruitment, interviewing, hiring and supporting these essential staff members.


