Learning Styles

We all have a dominant way or two of learning. This does not mean we cannot learn in other ways, but rather how we learn best. Take time to observe your child and see if you can discover their preferred learning style.

Kinesthetic Learners: Like to DO things

Ways to adjust their learning: Using manipulatives, tossing a ball back and forth (or jump) while learning math facts, spelling words, or reciting/repetition, use fidget toys to help “do” something while listening and/or reading, allow chewing gum while learning

Visual Learners: Like to SEE things

Ways to adjust their learning: Use graphic organizers, watch a video on the topic, using graphs and charts, using manipulatives, doing projects, hands-on experiments, and create a mnemonic

Auditory Learners: Like to LISTEN

Ways to adjust their learning: Engage in discussion on a topic, listen to audio books, do some read out louds for questions and study material, play soft background music (as opposed to silence), talk to self when working through problems, use song and beats to reinforce information, and use mnemonic methods
