The District 97 Policy Committee (Rance Clouser, Jim Gates and Chris Jasculca) has vetted the policies labeled Volume 15, Number 2 provided by Neola in spring 2010. The committee obtained additional information about these policies from Neola, HLERK (the district's legal counsel), and members of the administrative leadership team to ensure they are legally compliant and in alignment with the district's efforts to deliver a quality education to the children of Oak Park.

Attached are the policies that feature recommended changes from the committee. Revisions to existing district policies, which are printed in a standard District 97 format, are in bold text. Revisions to the new policies from Neola, which are printed on the company's letterhead, are handwritten in accordance with the company's procedures.
