School Board Goals 2014-15

Academic Standards

- Students in grade 1 will exceed the national mean growth target for reading and math by 5 RIT points from Fall 2014 to Spring 2015. Students in grade 2 will exceed the national mean growth target for reading and math by 3 RIT points from Fall 2014 to Spring 2015.
- MCA proficiency for grades 3-8, 10, and 11 tested in the Spring of 2015 will increase by 4% in comparison to the previous year.

Technology

- An additional 10% of ELOs will be supported by technology at the “modification” or “redefinition” level on the SAMR Scale. This will be completed at the end of the 2014-15 school year.

Financial

- The school district will comply with Policy 714 Fund balance and establish a minimum unassigned general fund balance of 8% by Fiscal Year 23.
