- Develop leadership and problem -solving skills that can be applied to challenges facing their schools
- Work with their building administration and other students and staff at their schools to address these challenges
- Network and learn from students at other schools

They should be willing to attend the meetings each month and communicate regularly with students in their building as well as with their building principal.
