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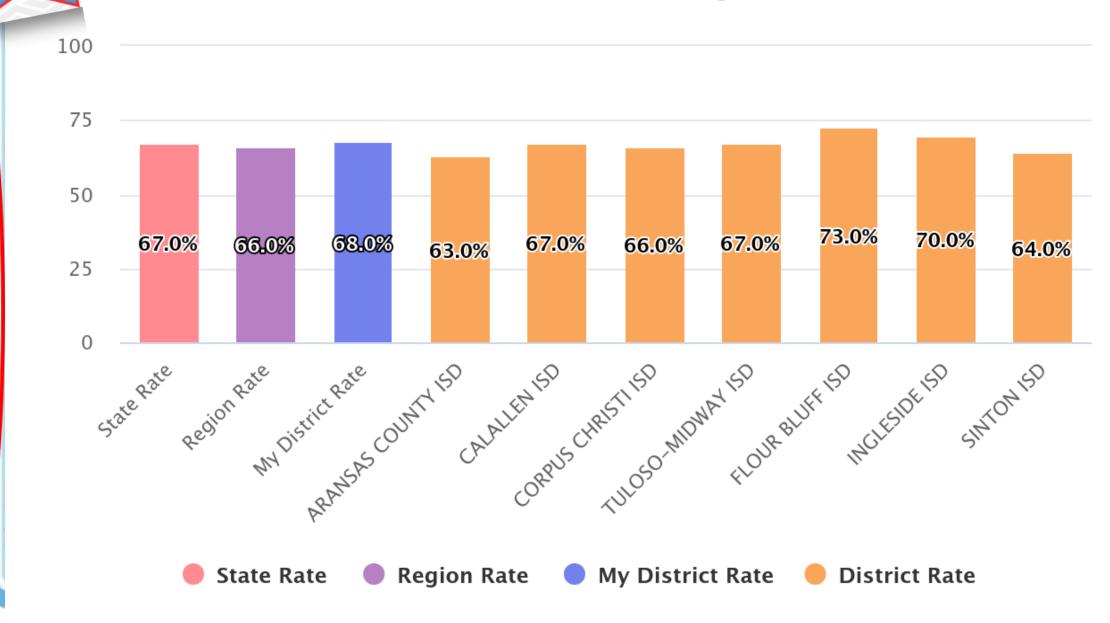
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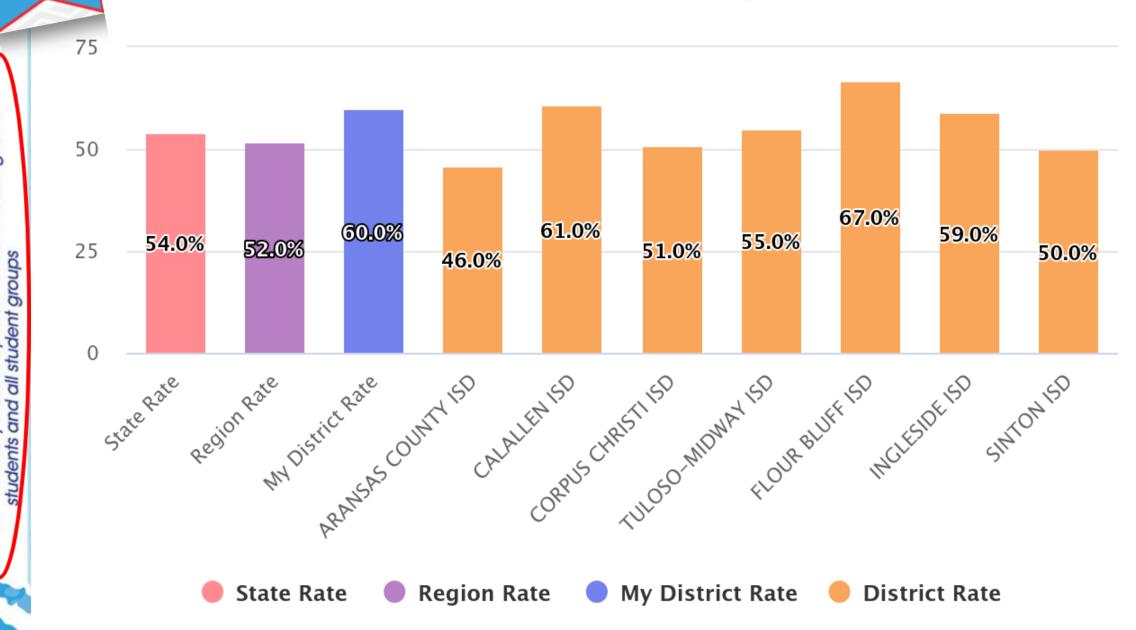

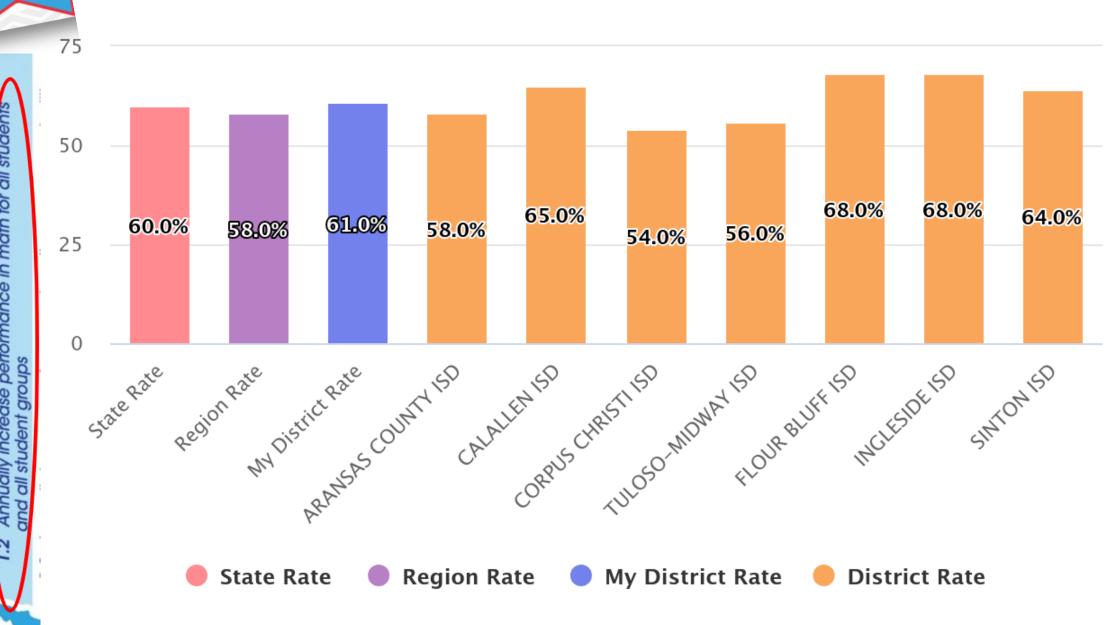


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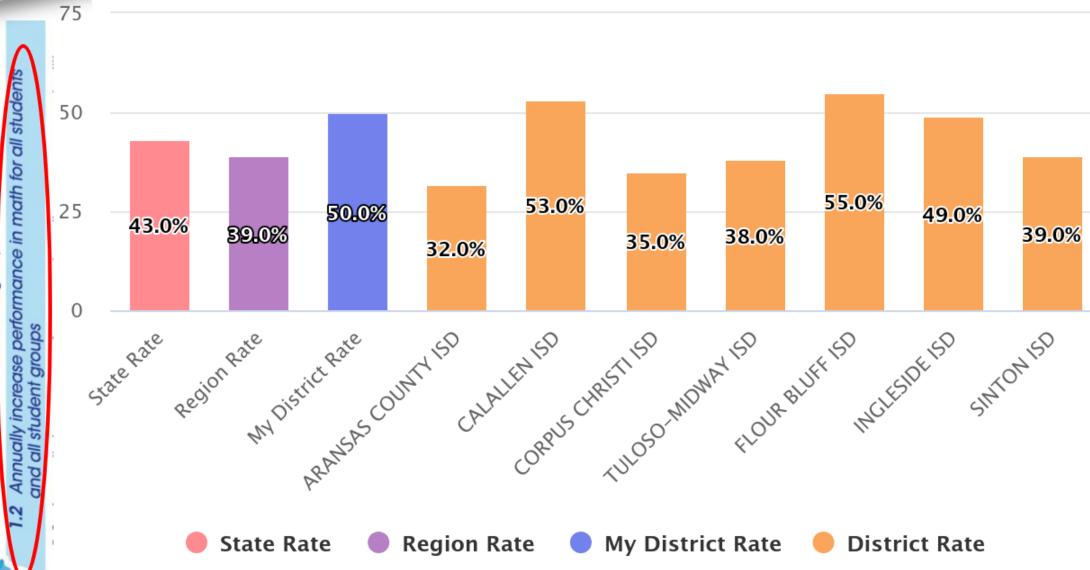




23-24 School Progress Domain - Annual Growth Score - All Grades Mathematics

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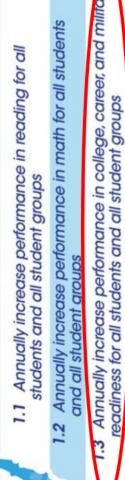
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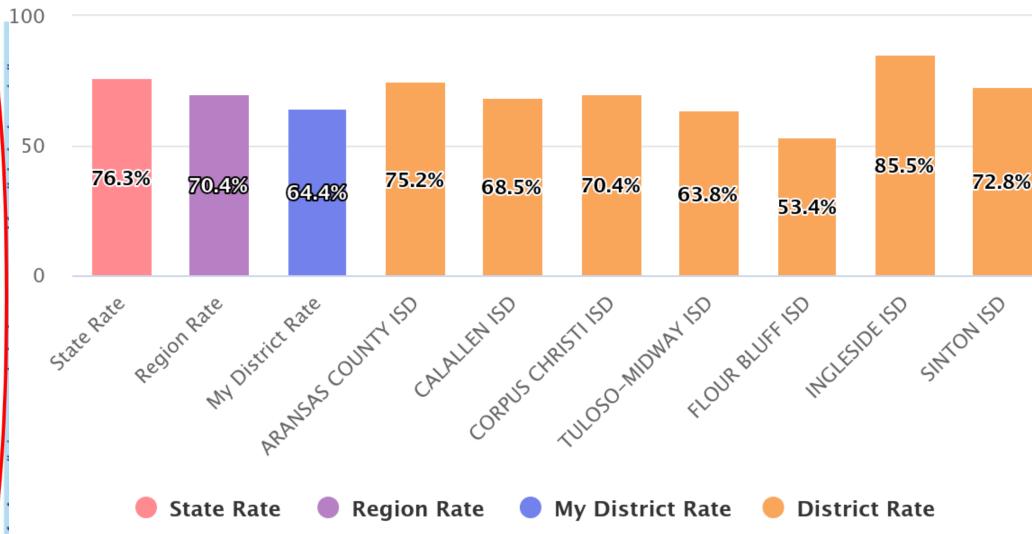




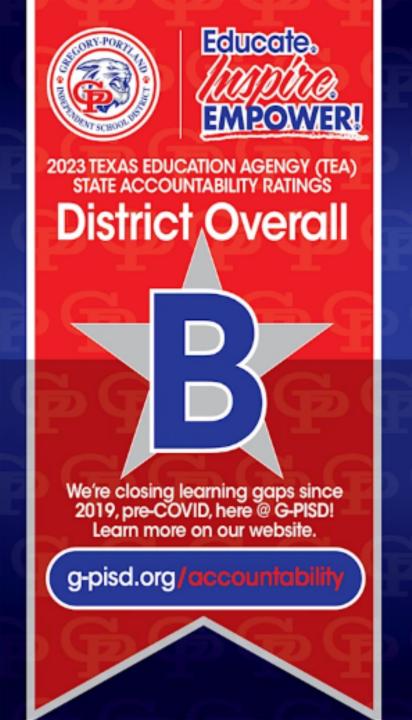


22-23 College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) - College, Career, and Military Ready Graduates - Annual Graduates





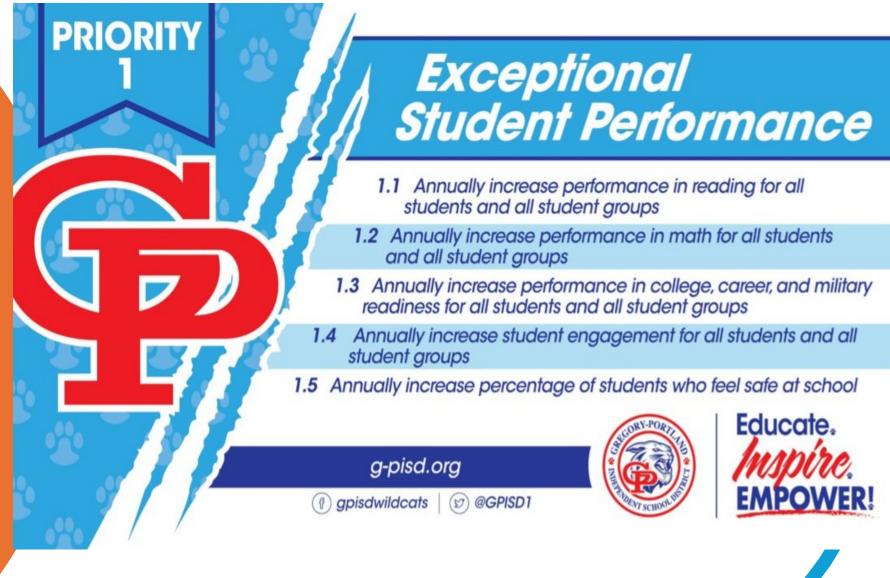
