DESCRIPTION:

Beginning in 2015, BHM Schools became a Q-Comp district which was locally named the Program for Professional Development (PPD). At times over the years, significant program changes have needed to be made to bring the budget in alignment with revenues and expenditures to be able to sustain the program.

The PPD Advisory Board, made up of four district administrators and four educator representatives, meet monthly to provide program oversight. When the expenditures begin to reach the point of overcoming the program revenue, this advisory board has analyzed what potential program changes could be considered that can still keep the integrity of the program in place.

The most recent program change for budget alignment went into effect for the 2024-2025 school year. At Monday's workshop, Jason Karn, PPD Coordinator, will highlight the current components of the PPD program and share the program evaluation strategies in place.
