

SUBJECT: Consideration and possible approval for J. Frank Dobie High School JROTC team members to travel to JROTC Fitness Championships in Daytona Beach, Florida on April 30, 2026 – May 5, 2026.

BACKGROUND: J. Frank Dobie AFJROTC squad requests permission for fourteen (14) students to travel to Daytona Beach, Florida to compete in JROTC Fitness Championships. The all-service national JROTC fitness challenge championship will lead the way in showcasing the finest, most hard working JROTC teams in the nation. The JROTC Fitness Nationals will attract many of the best male, mixed, and female JROTC fitness teams in the country. This single-day championship event will be a strong test for our program. The JROTC Fitness Nationals are designed to be a fun and exciting test of excellence that will take solid conditioning, teamwork, strategy, strength, quickness, power and determination, everything any solid PT/Athletic/Raider team maintains, all of which are looking to adjust fire and compete.

Fourteen (14) cadets led by MSgt. Greg Reyes and two (2) chaperones will attend this event. Participants will travel via ground transportation to Florida. All chaperones are trained in school district policy regarding responsibilities and duties prior to the trip. All rules of conduct established by the school district will be strictly enforced. All student travel guidelines and expectations will be followed according to Business Office Procedures.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS: Campus-based funds designated for the J. Frank Dobie AFJROTC Program will be used to fund the students. The approximate cost per participant is approximately \$2,000, not to exceed \$28,000 total for the trip.
