READING GOAL: Intermediate School Goal for reading: The percentage of all students in grades 3-5 at Princeton Intermediate School who are proficient on the MN alignment from fall to spring on the STAR Reading will increase from 53.0% in the spring of 2025 to 55.0% in the spring of 2026.

MATH GOAL: Intermediate School Goals for math: The percentage of all students in grades 3-5 at Princeton Intermediate School who are proficient on the MN alignment from fall to spring on the STAR Math will increase from 61.2% in the spring of 2025 to 63.2% in the spring of 2026.

Goal: Implement varied interventions to help 80% of students in classroom meet or exceed target.




- 1. Review the purpose, roles and responsibilities, and referral process with staff. As a support team, follow the process and checklist for each student.
