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## 4216 - SUPPORT STAFF DRESS AND GROOMING

The Board of Education believes that support staff members set an example in dress and grooming for their students to follow. are an important and integral part of the District. Also, since the support staff is highly-visible staff to the students, the professional staff, and the public, the Board believes the support staff should at all times be well dressed and groomed. Support staff members who understand this precept and adhere to it enlarge the importance of their task, present an image of dignity, and encourage respect.

The Board authorizes the development of standards for staff dress and grooming that promote a professional educational atmosphere that gives consideration to the impact on the educational process and the diversity of District's staff.

The Board retains the authority to specify the following dress and grooming guidelines for support staff. When assigned to District duty, all support staff members shall:

- A. be physically clean, and neat, and well groomed;
- B. dress in a manner consistent with their support responsibilities;
- C. dress in a manner that communicates to others a pride in personal appearance;
- D. dress in a manner that does not cause damage to District property;
- E. be groomed in such a way that their dress or hair style does not disrupt the educational process or cause a health or safety hazard.
