Stan Whittle presented the administration's recommendation to use LBK Roofing for replacing damaged roofs on the outbuildings at MFHS. Mr. Whittle included a list of the work needed as well as the cost for the project.

Upon a motion by Gary Boshears, second by Larry Berkman the board approved LBK Roofing as the contractor to remove and replace damaged roofs to the Marble Falls High School outbuildings in the amount of \$898,431.00.
