

Student Assessment Data

We are doing our winter testing window with Star Math and Reading. As of right now our students are showing growth and improvement. The students and teachers have been working diligently on learning through the essential standards. Its encouraging to see the data reflect those efforts thus far.

Target Time

Target time is designated time each day in which kids are working towards meeting their individualized learning targets. I have discussed it before, but I wanted to update on the fact that these targets are ever-changing and our groups are reconfigured based upon student learning. This is an effort to help kids learn what they are missing and grow upon what they already know. As of right now, these efforts are also seeing improvements.

Library Revamp

The Library continues to be under "construction" in regards to it being molded into a fun and exciting place for students to come and learn. Over break, Kim Gould worked on a Dr. Seuss mural to go along with the loft. The space has been opened up so many little places can be created for kids to sit down and read enjoyably. It has also been reorganized to be more student friendly based upon interests.

A team effort of the RACERS and the Social Emotional Learning Team (SELT) are working to create a week focused on kindness for our students. This will take place the week of January 28th-February 1st.

Behavioral Data

Through PBIS we have been tracking our student behavioral concerns in regards to Minors and Majors. Mrs. Gould and I have been working to make that data into a friendly format in which we can learn from. From this data, we have seen a consistent decrease in behavioral concerns.

Thematic Unit

This years thematic unit will be "Discover Wisconsin". We paired with the PTO to create the candy bar fund-raiser which raised over \$3,000 for the thematic unit. The planning committee will now begin creating a dynamic learning experience for our kids which is projected to take place in May.
