The planning committee has been working hard to schedule students with interviewers that align with their career pathway. A lot of time goes into planning this event and it would not be possible without the high school language arts teachers from each respective district coming together as a team.

Next Generation Science Exemplar (NGSx) training continues. Our 3rd of 5 sessions will be held on April 17th. This training is being provided by Chris Standerford and Kim Smith of NMU's Seaborg Center and is covered by MiSTEM 906C funding.

Our literacy grade level teams will be starting their third round of meetings this month. Tara will be joining each group to go over student growth for educator evaluation with them.
