Campus Improvement Plan Summary 2021-2022

- Reinstitute intervention math classes for students who have demonstrated gaps in learning; implement an accelerated plan to front-load upcoming concepts as well as review prior learning to help ensure mastery
- Continue to utilize NWEA MAPS as our universal screener for reading and math; use data to inform enrichment and intervention. Work to ensure student ownership of growth goals.
- Extend our content literacy focus to include authentic writing opportunities that challenge students to include justification and explanation for their responses utilizing key grammar and language norms.
- Continue to provide guidance lessons to all students that are both responsive to and proactive for relevant challenges faced at the junior high level.
- Explore and implement additional opportunities for consistent and timely communication to staff in order to facilitate both long-term planning and just-in-time reminders based on feedback and evaluation of efficiency.
- Implement the BRIDGES organization to provide intentional positive interactions, networking opportunities, and real-world experience for a diverse group of students
- Complete a 100% transition to Canvas as our primary Learning Management System (LMS) in order to provide a more robust platform, vertical alignment with the high school, and consistency for student and parents across all contents.

- Continue personalized development book clubs for staff members to engage in collaborative reading based on their individual/departmental development needs
- To the greatest extent possible, provide the required HB4545 tutorials through our scheduled advisory time while maintaining the integrity of IXL intervention/enrichment and sustained silent reading time for all students.
- Based on staff input and vision, begin an intentional shift to collaborative learning spaces within the classroom.
- Reimagine our library as an interactive learning space in which students are able to access literature, digital resources, hands-on activities, video production, and other collaborative opportunities to extend our classrooms.
