**News/Notes**

- The Fall Athletics season is wrapping up with all of the teams looking ahead to the PostSeason. Cross Country and Tennis are currently into their PostSeason while the Football and Volleyball teams are finishing up the Regular Season this week. It has been a successful Fall season so far with big crowds and great fan sections at our Home Events.

**Athletics Updates****Tennis**

- Ranger Tennis completed their season at the individual Section 7A championships this week where Tori Oehrlein finished 4th overall. They finished up the Team portion of their season last week with a Victory in the QuarterFinals over Mora 5-2 but fell in the SemiFinals to the #1 seed Pine City. Oehrlein & Margaret Silgen both secured the 50th career Victory of their Ranger Careers joining a select group and being the only two who have done it mostly as singles competitors.

**Volleyball**

- The Volleyball team wraps up their Regular Season this Wednesday evening against Moose Lake/Willow River before starting PostSeason play next week. Their record is at 8-14 on the season and they are sitting #6 in the SubSection meaning they will start on the road in the 1st Round of the playoffs. A highlight of the season was defeating Aitkin 3-1 in the "Fight for the Cure" Annual Match.

**Football**

- The Football team finishes up the Regular Season with a Home Game vs Hinckley-Finlayson and looks to finish the season with an above .500 record. Currently they sit at 4-3, are 5th in the Section ranking but still have a chance to host a 1st Round playoff game next week. They defeated Greenway/Nashwauk-Keewatin last Friday 34-6.

**Cross Country**

- The Ranger Cross Country team competed at the final Mid-State Conference Championships this week with four individuals earning All-Conference honors. Gabby Rosecrans was named to the All-Conference team while Joe Ringhand, Maddie Lacerte and Ruby Westin were all named Honorable Mention. Two weeks ago they hosted the Ranger Invite at Rutgers Golf Course. Joe Ringhand won the boys individual race becoming only the 10th boy in C-I history to win multiple individual races in the same season. The girls finished 2nd as a team at the same meet. Next up is a chance to qualify for the State Championships at the Section 7A Championships next Thursday, October 26th.
