Summary: The Course Selection Guide (CSG) contains all courses offered

at Colleyville Heritage High School, Grapevine High School, Cross Timbers Middle School, Colleyville Middle School, Grapevine Middle School, and Heritage Middle School. The attached list shows the recommended additions, revisions, and

deletions.

Between September and November, campus and central office leaders worked to review the existing course offerings and determine necessary revisions based on local and state factors.

Legislative and Standards Changes - SB 1191 (GPA Weighting): The commissioner may develop a standard method for computing high school GPA, giving equal, additional weight to Honors, AP, IB, OnRamps dual enrollment, and non-Workforce Education dual credit courses. This is expected to potentially increase interest in dual credit courses.

All additions, deletions, and revisions were made after stakeholder feedback and with the lens of what is best for the student. The main changes are listed below:

- At least ten distinct changes to the CSG that are mandated by or directly related to legislative, standards, or updated course offerings by the Texas Education Agency (TEA) or related state codes (PEIMS).
- Seven CTE courses were revised to provide students with opportunities to access them to complete certain pathways, certifications, and earn advanced credit.
- Five distinct revisions, deletions, or additions made to course prerequisites or prerequisite policies.
- Two CTE courses were deleted due to restructuring or limited interest in the program of study.
- Eighteen distinct course additions, deletions, or revisions that were mandated by the Texas Education Agency (TEA) or made to enhance dual credit options for students.
