This list is school instructions, not medical advice. Please contact your health care provider with health concerns.

SYMPTOMS OF ILLNESS	THE STUDENT MAY RETURN AFTER... *The list below tells the shortest time to stay home. A student may need to stay home longer for some illnesses.
 Fever: temperature of 100.4°F (38°C) or greater	*Fever-free for 24 hours without taking fever-reducing medicine.
 New cough illness	*Symptoms improving for 24 hours (no cough or cough is well-controlled).
 New difficulty breathing	*Symptoms improving for 24 hours (breathing comfortably). <i>Urgent medical care may be needed.</i>
 Diarrhea: 3 loose or watery stools in a day OR not able to control bowel movements	*Symptoms improving for 24 hours (no more than two bowel movements more than normal and no longer having accidents) OR with orders from doctor to school nurse.
 Vomiting: one or more episode that is unexplained	*Symptom-free for 24 hours OR with orders from doctor to school nurse.
 Headache with stiff neck and fever	*Symptom-free OR with orders from doctor to school nurse. Follow fever instructions above. <i>Urgent medical care may be needed.</i>
Skin rash or open sores	*Symptom free, which means rash is gone OR sores are dry or can be completely covered by a bandage OR with orders from doctor to school nurse.
Red eyes with colored drainage	*Symptom-free, which means redness and drainage are gone OR with orders from doctor to school nurse.
Jaundice: new yellow color in eyes or skin	*After the school has orders from doctor or local public health authority to school nurse.
Acting differently without a reason: unusually sleepy, grumpy, or confused.	*Symptom-free, which means return to normal behavior OR with orders from doctor to school nurse.
Major health event, like an illness lasting 2 or more weeks OR a hospital stay, OR health condition requires more care than school staff can safely provide.	*After the school has orders from doctor to school nurse AND after measures are in place for the student's safety. Please work with school staff to address special health-care needs so the student may attend safely.

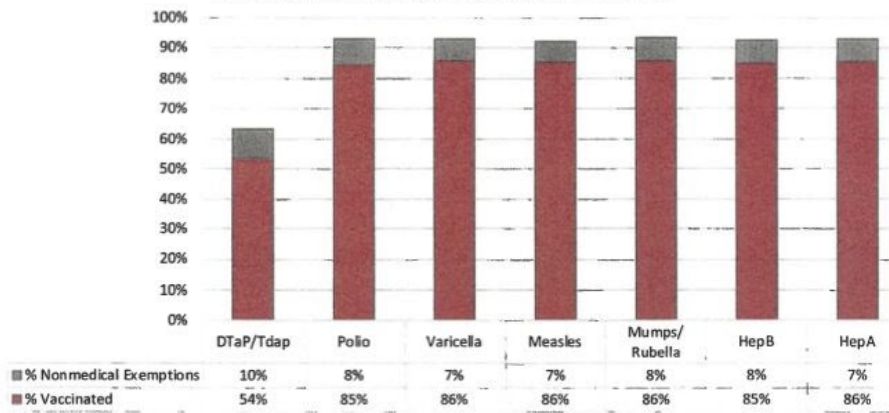

 Fiebre: temperatura igual o superior a 100.4°F (38°C)	*La siguiente lista indica el tiempo más corto para quedarse en casa. Es posible que un estudiante deba permanecer en casa más tiempo por algunas enfermedades. *No tener fiebre durante 24 horas sin tomar medicamentos antifebriles.
 Nueva enfermedad de tos	* Los síntomas han mejorado durante 24 horas (no tos o la tos está bien controlada).
 Nueva dificultad para respirar	* Los síntomas han mejorado durante 24 horas (respiración con comodidad). Es posible que se necesite atención médica urgente.
 Diarrea: 3 deposiciones blandas o acuosas en un día O no puede controlar las deposiciones	*Sin síntomas durante 24 horas O con órdenes del médico a la enfermera de la escuela.
 Vómitos: uno o más episodios inexplicables	*Sin síntomas durante 24 horas O con órdenes del médico a la enfermera de la escuela.
 Dolor de cabeza con rigidez de nuca y fiebre	*Sin síntomas O con órdenes del médico a la enfermera escolar. Siga las instrucciones anteriores para la fiebre. Es posible que se necesite atención médica urgente.
Erupción cutánea o llagas abiertas	*Sin síntomas , lo que significa que la erupción ha desaparecido O que las llagas están secas o pueden cubrirse completamente con un vendaje. O con órdenes del médico a la enfermera de la escuela.
Ojos rojos con supuración de color	*Sin síntomas , lo que significa que el enrojecimiento y la supuración han desaparecido O con órdenes del médico a la enfermera de la escuela.
Ictericia: nuevo color amarillo en ojos o piel	*Después de que la escuela tenga instrucciones del médico o de la autoridad local de salud pública para la enfermera escolar.
Actuar de manera diferente sin una razón: inusualmente somnoliento, gruñón o confundido.	*Sin síntomas , lo que significa volver al comportamiento normal O con órdenes del médico a la enfermera de la escuela.
Acontecimiento de salud importante, como una enfermedad que dure 2 o más semanas O una hospitalización, O estado de salud que requiere más cuidados de los que el personal de la escuela puede proporcionar con seguridad.	*Después de que la escuela tenga órdenes del médico a la enfermera de la escuela Y después de que se hayan tomado medidas para la seguridad del estudiante. Por favor, colabore con el personal de la escuela para abordar las necesidades especiales de cuidado de salud para que el estudiante pueda asistir a la escuela con seguridad.

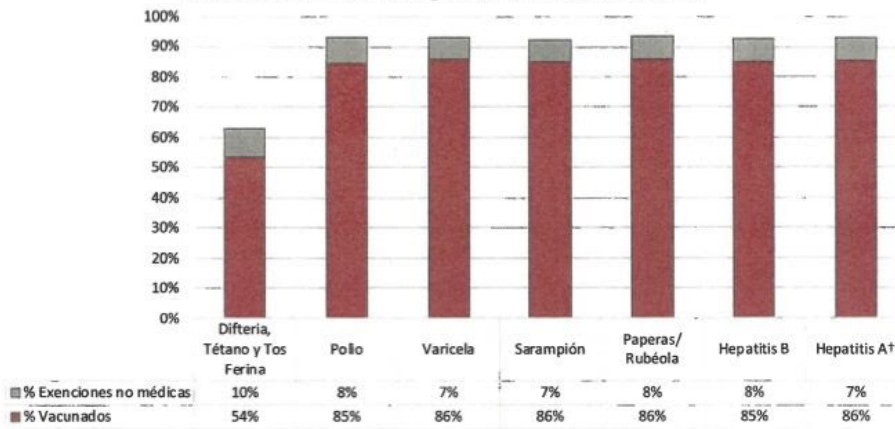
