



HISTORICAL CONTEXT

Assumed management of SE AR Preparatory
Academy in spring 2020

Opened FAASEPB in the fall of 2020 with grades 10 – 12, and a commitment to seeing each SE scholar graduate from their school.

The campus decreased a grade each year (current 12th grade & 5th grade) with a plan to drop to 6th grade and add a grade each year until the campus is 6 – 12.



Comparison to LR Charter Elementary Schools







This data is used to set and gauge year end goals for each student.


Frequent analysis allows for necessary adjustments in instructional practices.
