Staffing

The Transportation Department continues to remain fully staffed. One driver is scheduled for her final required training class and is expected to obtain her CDL at that time. We have also added a new substitute driver to support spring athletic trips and additional transportation needs.

Fleet and Maintenance

The department continues the scheduled maintenance cycle for the bus fleet. Preventative maintenance remains a priority to support safe and reliable transportation. We are also continuing to complete maintenance on additional district vehicles, which allows the district to avoid outsourcing these services and helps reduce overall maintenance costs.

Operations

The Transportation Department continues to refine communication procedures to support clearer and more timely communication between drivers, schools, and parents. Efforts to improve communication regarding delayed buses are ongoing. Daily transportation operations continue to run reliably for students and families across the district.
