Register online for the ACT at www.actstudent.org. The ACT test is \$47 with Writing.

PSAT

11th grades students planning to attend a four year college should sign up to take the PSAT. The PSAT will be administered on Wednesday, October 13th. Juniors will be charged a \$14 fee. Please see the counseling office if you would like to sign up to take the test. Students who take the PSAT tend to score higher on the SAT. SAT and ACT scores are an entrance requirement for most universities. It is a great idea to take this test!

If the book you want has been checked out I can put a hold on it so when it is returned you can check it out next, just let me know.




HOW DO I FIND OUT ABOUT UPCOMING EVENTS
