# Important Reminders

We have just a few items we would like to remind students and parents about. They are...

\*If you have a change in your child's after school transportation (i.e. different bus, pick up, etc.), please call it in to the office *prior* to 2pm.

\*As winter approaches, we may face school closures due to inclement weather. In addition to FlashAlert and the district web page, you may call the middle school office at 503-355-2990 for closure updates. When possible the district will initiate calls to all families via the automated call system.

\*When providing permission for bus passes, please remember to include city, bus number, and bus stop location.


\*Please be sure to call the office (503-355-2990 or 866-966-2990) prior to 8:45 a.m if your student is going to be absent. We have a 24-hour phone message line and an automated call system.

\*Students absent from school due to illness or unexcused absence are not permitted to attend after-school activities on the day of their absence.

\*Middle school students are not allowed to carry medications. (This includes cough drops, aspirin, vitamins, etc.) Parents must check ALL medications in and out at the office.

\*Unless specifically stated, the standard dress code applies to all school events and activities. \*Students should not arrive at school prior to 8:15 am and 9:30 am on late start Mondays. Students not involved in extra curricular activities are not allowed to remain on campus after the end of the school day.

\*The handbook provides clear guidelines for electronics. Students may not use cell phones while at school.
