AGENDA ITEM: Canvass Election Returns for May 9, 2015 Bond Election

ALIGNS TO BOARD GOAL(S): Parents/Community – Parents and members of the community will have meaningful opportunities to participate in the educational processes of the Aledo ISD.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

• On February 25, 2015, the Board of Trustees approved an Order Calling a Bond Election for May 9, 2015.

ADMINISTRATIVE CONSIDERATIONS:

- Election returns for the Aledo ISD bond election held on May 9, 2015 are presented to the Board of Trustees so the official canvass may be conducted.
- The <u>un-official</u> election results shown on the following page are the totals provided to the District by the Parker County Elections Department on Saturday, May 9th.
- Also provided for your review is an Order Canvassing Bond Election Returns prepared by the District's bond attorneys, McCall, Parkhurst & Horton L.L.P.
- Since provisional ballots were cast in the bond election, the District will not receive <u>official</u> election results from the Parker County Elections Department until Monday, May 18th. At that time, this Board Meeting Template and Order Canvassing Bond Election Returns will be updated and then provided to you at the Board of Trustees meeting Monday night.

ORDER CANVASSING BOND ELECTION RETURNS

THE STATE OF TEXAS	:
COUNTIES OF PARKER AND TARRANT	:
ALEDO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT	:

WHEREAS, this Board of Trustees ordered an election to be held in said District on May 9, 2015 on the PROPOSITIONS hereinafter stated; and

WHEREAS, said Board of Trustees has investigated all matters pertaining to said election, including the ordering, giving notice, officers, holding and making returns of said election; and

WHEREAS, the election officers who held said election have duly made the returns of the result thereof, and said returns have been duly delivered to said Board of Trustees.

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Order was adopted was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF ALEDO INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

1. That the Board of Trustees officially finds and determines that said election was duly ordered, that proper notice of said election was duly given, that proper election officers were duly appointed prior to said election, that said election was duly held, that the District has complied with the Federal Voting Rights Act and the Texas Election Code, that due returns of the result of said election have been made and delivered, and that the Board of Trustees has duly canvassed said returns, all in accordance with law and the Order calling said election.

2. That the Board of Trustees officially finds and determines that the following votes were cast at said election, on the submitted PROPOSITIONS by the resident, qualified electors of said District, who voted at the election:

PROPOSITION NO. 1

FOR The issuance of \$28,800,000 of bonds by Aledo Independent School District for the construction, acquisition and equipment of school buildings in the District, to wit: a new elementary school and levying the tax in payment thereof, including the costs of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds. AGAINST

PROPOSITION NO.2

FOR

The issuance of \$24,400,000 of bonds by Aledo Independent School District for the construction, acquisition and equipment of school buildings in the District, including the purchase of new school buses, to wit: purchase new school buses and for safety and security improvements, technology upgrades and renovations and improvements district-wide and levying the tax in payment thereof, including the costs of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds.

AGAINST

3. That the Board of Trustees officially finds, determines and declares the result of said election to be that PROPOSITION NO. 1 so submitted has [received a favorable majority vote in all respects and has carried][failed].

4. That the Board of Trustees officially finds, determines and declares the result of said election to be that PROPOSITION NO. 2 so submitted has [received a favorable majority vote in all respects and has carried][failed].

5. That any of the aforesaid bonds having received a favorable majority vote may be issued, and the aforesaid bond tax may be levied, assessed and collected annually as voted and provided by law.
