Our TA's have to cover specials so that our teachers can have a break to plan and prep. With their help we are able to offer BNAS, PE, Spanish, Library, Art and Computers. We had 3 students transfer out of District. Currently we are at 28 students.

Here is a brief summary of what our 3-6 grade classrooms are working on:

Mrs. Reed's specials classes: art: color wheel, color theory, drawing techniques, paint strokes, 3-D objects with paper,

Blackfeet studies - Robert Hall presenter, teaching the Blackfoot words for numbers colors, objects, greetings, and animals.

Library- Students select stories then each child reads a page in meetings or I will read a book. Parts of the book are also covered. (i.e. Title page, illustrations)

PE- Students have been doing yoga lessons, stretching, walking, and running in place.

Computers- Topics regarding scams, how to send e-mails , parts of the iPad, and the do not's about social media have been covered.

3-6 grades--Mrs. Augare
