Re: Approval of TEA Ed-Flex Schoolwide Eligibility Waivers

Background: Texas has received approval from the U.S. Department of Education to continue its Ed-Flex waiver authority under the Education Flexibility Partnership Act of 1999, as amended by the Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015 (ESSA), through the 2023-2024 school year.

Statewide programmatic waivers address design and delivery of federal programs covered under Ed-Flex and allow LEAs can design and implement programs in ways that best meet the needs of their students and communities.

This waiver allows any campus otherwise eligible to receive Title I, Part A, funds to implement a Title I, Part A, schoolwide program regardless of the percentage of students from low-income families.

To be eligible for this waiver, the campuses listed below have completed the following tasks:

1. Planned and aligned the ten components of the Title 1, Part A Schoolwide program with the Campus Improvement Plan during the 2020-21 school year;
2. Trained campus site-based decision-making committee members on the ten components of a Title 1, Part A Schoolwide program;
3. Identified the targeted goals for the 2020-21 Campus Improvement Plan; and
4. Established a completion date for the 2020-21 Campus Improvement Plan
