

#### FastBridge Reading Mid-Year Growth







## Key Takeaways



- Effective Tier 1 Instruction: Reading and math instruction continue to meet core (Tier 1) needs.
- □ MTSS Success: At least 3% of kindergarten and first-grade students have successfully exited MTSS support in both reading and math.
- Math Progress: Kindergarten and first-grade math students are showing more decreases in their level of support than increases
- Growth Exceeding Projections: All grade levels are exceeding projected growth in reading and math at the mid-year check-in.
- Reading Improvement: RIT scores in reading have increased across all grade levels.
- Target Support Continues: WIN and intervention support will continue, guided by MAP, FastBridge, IXL, and ALEKS progress monitoring data.
