- Explore options during summer 2025
- Pilot 2 resources during 25/26
- Implementation in 26/27



# Middle School Social Studies


#### Criteria for Pilot:

- Engaging and interactive
- Global issues
- Culturally inclusive, includes diverse perspectives
- Address the updated Illinois instructional mandates and standards



# High School Math Current Reality


- Curriculum Council members shared the need for a common, updated resource for core math classes
- Currently, we use the College Board frameworks to guide instruction





# **High School Math - Desired Criteria**

- Alignment with the College Board Framework and Common Core State Standards
- Comprehensive Algebra 1/Geometry/Algebra 2 resources which include statistics







### **Product Selection Process**

- A resource review team will meet with vendors and review options for the potential pilot
- Anticipate that two resources will be piloted by all participants one resource piloted during 1st semester, with the other resource piloted 2nd semester

August - December	Pilot resource one
January - May	Pilot resource two
April/May	Review feedback and make recommendation to Board of Education for purchase
