BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF DENTON INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

<u>Section 1</u>. Exhibit A to the Election Order is hereby amended to read as set forth on Exhibit A attached hereto.

<u>Section 2</u>. The Superintendent of the District is hereby authorized and directed to approve any changes or corrections to the exhibit attached hereto as may be necessary to reflect any changes to polling locations and times and/or as otherwise designated by the Denton County Elections Division.

Section 3. A substantial copy of the Election Order, as amended herein, shall serve as the notice of election to be posted and published as prescribed by Section 9 of the Election Order and in accordance with law. Posting and publication of the notice of election with the polling places as designated herein is hereby ratified and approved.

<u>Section 4</u>. The Election Order, as amended herein, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. This Order shall be effective immediately from and after its passage.
