ADMISSIONS: INTERDISTRICT TRANSFERS

TRANSFER REQUESTS

No nonresident students shall be permitted to attend District schools except as provided below.

EXCEPTIONS

1. Children of nonresident District employees shall be eligible to attend District schools in accordance with DEB(LOCAL).

2 Guidelines for transfers may be found in Regulation FDA

If parents have moved outside of the District after the student completes his or her junior year in the District, the parents may request permission in writing from the Superintendent or designee for the student to complete his or her senior year. If the principal recommends the student not be permitted to attend District schools for disciplinary or other reasons, the request may not be granted.

Students whose families move out of the District during the school year may continue to attend schools in the District until the conclusion of the current grading period (either six or nine weeks), provided there is not a recommendation from the principal that the student not continue to attend for disciplinary or other reasons. The Superintendent or designee may allow continued attendance for a longer period of time when unusual circumstances warrant.

During this time there shall be no tuition charge. Students attending school under this condition shall not be provided transportation.

TUITION

The Board shall determine annually and within statutory limits the amount of tuition, if any, to be charged.

WAIVERS

The Superintendent may waive tuition requirements upon written application by the student or parent(s)/guardian, with the administration's recommendation. This decision shall not be based on race, sex, color, creed, religion, national origin or disability.

NONPAYMENT

The District may initiate withdrawal of students whose tuition payments are delinquent.

APPEALS Any appeals shall be made in accordance with FNG(LOCAL) and GF(LOCAL), as appropriate.
