POLICY ISSUE/SITUATION

The scope of the work includes an extended covered play structure, canopy, modifications to drainage, and site grading improvements in the center courtyard. Addition of a temporary double-classroom portable will be sited off the classroom wing until the new Bethany K5 is constructed.

PROJECT NAME: Capital Center Improvements

PROJECT TIMELINE: 10/05/14 - 08/29/15

PROJECT SCOPE:

The east section of the building is in need of a new roof and associated seismic upgrades. A new HVAC system is needed to replace rooftop units which are very energy inefficient and have far exceeded their lifespan. Building improvements will be made to house the School of Science and Technology and the SPED Transition Services program spaces will be expanded.

Create an additional data center in the Capital Center building. Each will be a state-of-the-art center and will house the District's servers and data storage medium to support the entire District network. Creation of this data center includes purchasing of new servers and hardware, UPS, emergency generators, fire protection, security access and video surveillance camera systems.

Relocate Deer Park Academy to Capital Center.

PROJECT NAME: Conestoga Middle School Re-Roofing & HVAC Improvements

PROJECT TIMELINE: 6/15/15-9/30/15

PROJECT BUDGET: \$3,273,480

PROJECT SCOPE:

Re- roof the existing roofing system with a Fully Adhered 90 mil EPDM roofing membrane. Remove and replace moisture impacted roofing. Purchase and install new roof access ladders. Purchase and install Fall Protection Anchors.

CONTRACT NAME: Conestoga Middle School Re-Roofing. SOLICITATION METHOD: Invitation to Bid

CONTRACT TIMELINE: 6/15/15-9/30/15

CONTRACT AMOUNT: \$2,600,000

CONTRACT SCOPE:

Construction Contract for re-roofing. A separate construction contract (not included in this award) for the HVAC work will be issued.

PROJECT NAME: New Middle School

PROJECTTIMELINE: 5/27/14-10/28/16

PROJECT BUDGET: \$58,920,751

PROJECT SCOPE:

Construct an 1100-student Middle school facility on the Timberland site to provide additional District capacity for middle school students. This school is a critical component of the 2014 Bond because it will be used as a temporary elementary school for schools undergoing replacement construction.

CONTRACT NAME: Pre-GMP Bid Package 4

CONTRACTTIMELINE: 5/19/15-6/1/16

CONTRACT AMOUNT: \$1,955,000

SOLICITATION METHOD: CMGC Bid Package

CONTRACT SCOPE:

- 1. Preconstruction award (already authorized & done Skanska is contractor)
- 2. CMGC approach provides for a GMP change order for whole construction effort when design has reached sufficient detail to obtain Bids, but due to very compressed schedule, we need to selectively authorize certain pre-GMP early subcontract bid package change orders for long-lead time procurements and for selected critical-path work items that cannot wait. This is one of the benefits of using the CMGC tool as it allows overlap of final design work and the beginning of construction.
- 3. Thus, this contract action allows for a pre-GMP change order to the CMGC contract for masonry and masonry trade labor, because of long lead procurement of masonry products.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve award of pre-GMP construction Change Order.
