WE Collaborate: Bond Projects expose students to new career and trades – Bassetti Architects & Five Oaks Middle School

Thousands of Beaverton School District students are benefitting from the 2014 Bond Program through new schools, technology, repairs and improvements. But they are also being exposed to many careers and trades surrounding the construction industry as well.

A perfect example of this collaboration is the partnership between Five Oaks Middle School and Bassetti Architects, the firm designing the modernization of the middle school. Architects are teaching monthly workshops to students in the school's Opportunity YOU after-school program, free of charge. In addition, the student feedback from the workshops will be used to inform the design of some of the new spaces in the school.

The monthly workshops run from January through May. The first workshop was a photo scavenger hunt and space activity. Using provided iPads, student groups tried to find and take pictures of architectural elements within the school. They also described a social space and personal space that they liked and disliked within the school.

Future workshops include describing a space using the five senses, a field trip to explore how architecture represents or could represent personal culture and a collage that shows the spirit of Five Oaks.
