Administrative Recommendation	The Administration recommends the approval of the Crosby High School JROTC to participate in military exercises and tour at Ft. Johnson in Ft. Johnson, Louisiana from July 30 – 31, 2025.
Authority for this Action	Board Policy, FMG (LOCAL) Any out-of-state trips taken by student organizations or other student groups shall require approval from the Board.
Goal/Objective Addressed	District Goal 4: Co-Curricular Activities Crosby ISD will develop co-curricular programs which enhance students' educational experiences, academic achievement and school and community pride.
Background	The Crosby High School JROTC will have an opportunity to tour and participate in the daily exercises of a soldier at Ft. Johnson Military Installment. The Army Cadet Command requires cadets to participate in 46 events a year to enhance their educational experience, academic achievement, and school and community pride. This tour allows military bound Crosby cadets to experience firsthand a typical day in the life of a soldier. The intent is for this contact to motivate them to continue or choose another path as they explore options after high school.
Staffing Implications	The trip takes place after school hours on an instructional day followed by a non-instructional day. Therefore, no additional staff members will be needed.
Budget Information	The cost of the trip is \$6,210.34. This amount is covered by JROTC extra-curricular funds. There is no cost to cadets or chaperones. One female and one male chaperone will attend the trip.
Impact of this Action	Members of the JROTC will have an opportunity to represent Crosby High School as they tour Ft. Johnson Military Installation and experience a day in the life of a typical soldier. This experience will allow military bound cadets to explore their future options by experiencing firsthand a typical day in their future.
