## Updates

- Faith signed us up for the Day on the Hill with ISBA. It will be virtual. School board members will be receiving a link from ISBA to attend if it works in your schedule.
- Terry Reilly used HMS as a site for a Covid vaccine clinic on January 29<sup>th</sup>. The clinic was open to staff as well as others from the community. 100 vaccines were administered. Terry Reilly has asked to use HMS again to support the seniors in the community with access to another clinic for those interested in getting the vaccine. The online registration and traveling to Caldwell or Nampa has proven to be difficult.
- The legislative session continues to change daily. Bills are starting to get introduced at a quicker pace and possible impact on districts is starting to take shape. The executive and legislative branches are continuing to navigate their differences.
- Superintendents from around the state have met with the leaders of CTE (Career Technical Education) to advocate for more opportunities for in-person competitions for students this spring instead of just virtual. CTE leadership didn't seem as interested as the school districts in putting together in-person options. We will continue to push on this issue.
