Alaska Education & Legislative Session

This week we will learn if Governor Dunleavy will choose to accept the Legislature's SB140 Amendment to increase the Base Student Allocation by \$680, monies for correspondence study and implementation of the Reads Act as well as an easing of rules to form charter schools. We are so grateful to have stayed close to this Legislative session through our relationship with Representative Bryce Edgmon guiding our consortium of Districts through messaging, and insights to meetings with Senators and Legislators.

Small School Intent to Enroll for 2024-2025 We intend to send out our intent to enroll forms to small school sites (those with 15 or fewer currently enrolled students) so we can make predictions for staffing and funding for schools in the year ahead.
