VII. PRESIDENT'S REPORT

President Braun paused the meeting for a break from 7:12 - 7:21 p.m.

President Braun provided a President's report on attorney bills, the tax flyer with QR code, Team of 8 Training, District committees, the Balanced Scorecard Report, and shared cost-cutting measures over the last few years.

VIII. EXECUTIVE SESSION

No executive session was held.

IX. REPORTS OF THE SUPERINTENDENT

A. GCISD Scorecard Priority 4 Update: Financial Outlook and Long Range Facility Management Plan

The GCISD Balanced Scorecard Priority Report update was on Priority 4: Strong Financial Stewardship and Internal System Efficiency.

COO Paula Barbaroux recapped the purpose of the Education Master Planning Committee (EMPC) and the enrollment decline. She shared the structured approach for evaluating facilities and options.

She reviewed the rubric information again this month. She shared the status of the long term plan, which includes consideration of school consolidations, revenue generation, and consideration of feeder patterns. She provided an overview of each of the EMPC meetings since the update at the October 27 board meeting. She explained how the committee came to make its recommendations by sharing the feasibility analysis the committee used and how the committee then focused on a narrower list of considerations based on the feasibility analysis. She shared the feasibility considerations.

She discussed the committee recommendations which include: consolidation of Dove Elementary into Cannon Elementary and Silver Lake Elementary; consolidation of Bransford into Colleyville Elementary School (CES) and O.C. Taylor Elementary School (OCT) with some students from CES moving to Glenhope and some students from OCT moving to Heritage Elementary School; selling of district properties (PDEC, Heritage Annex, Dove, ECDC, and evaluation of selling the second campus site); evaluate the revenue projects on the submitted list, and others that may be submitted in the future; include a deed restriction on all property sales so that new owners may not compete with the school district (school or child care facility); and further pursue a feeder pattern from elementary to high school based on remaining schools, with grandfathering to the extent the demographer modeling allows.

The benefits of the recommendations from a financial standpoint were discussed. CFO David Johnson shared the financial outlook. He reviewed historical and prospective information, including formula funds and other maintenance and operations (M&O) revenue. He shared there is an expected decline in interest revenue. He discussed the benefit to the fund balance after campus consolidations and shared the projections of financial data did not include raises, recapture, TIF payments, or selling of properties.

Paula Barbaroux shared important dates, including campus staff meetings this week, special board meetings on December 2 and 10, and the creation of consolidation Task Force with subcommittees in January of 2026.

Questions and comments took place.
