On-site at all 8 elementary schools


193 days of school year programming Every day school is in session: dismissal – 6 p.m. School holidays and in-service days: 7:30 am – 6 pm

645 children from 485 families

46% are low to middle income





Enrollment is open to all D97 children whose parents are working or attending schools/training during the after-school hours.

Sliding Scale Fee based on income

Options to attend 1-5 days per week



Priority enrollment given to families referred by District 97 and local social service agencies.
