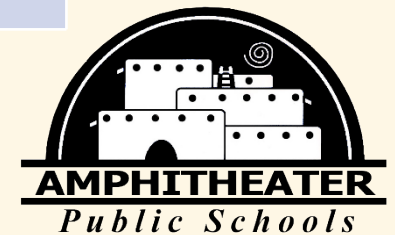

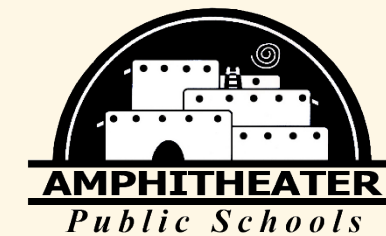

Amphitheater Mentoring Program



Purpose: To provide a three-year induction program to provide new teachers with effective support and opportunities to become reflective educators, to increase competence in their practice, to inspire them to continue in the profession, and to create self-directed leaders and learners.

- All teachers in their first, second and third year of teaching are assigned a mentor from the Amphi Curriculum Intervention and Instructional Support Specialists team (CISS)
- Work with new teachers on a weekly basis
- Partner with CISS for at least two Student Centered Coaching Cycles: (1-2 weeks) focused on learning target, co-planning session, co-teaching session, goals and outcomes documented through coaching log
- May include Whisper Coaching
- Each campus has a CISS this school year!

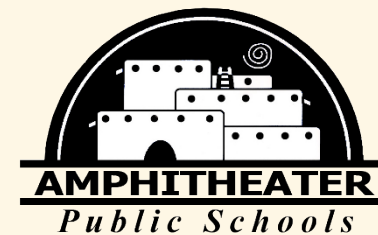
