**Credit & Debt** 

How you can borrow money and show you can repay it Example: Taking steps to show you can repay money you borrow.

Banking, Investing, Repayment & Savings This means different ways to make your money grow over time Example: Different types of bank accounts

Budgeting, Spending & Money Management

This means tracking what money you earn and what you spend on Example: Common costs like rent or food

Personal Income, Taxes & Services This means the fees you pay to the government from what you earn Example: Filling out federal and state tax forms

Maintaining Financial Well-being This means taking care of your money so you can meet your goals Example: Protecting your financial data
