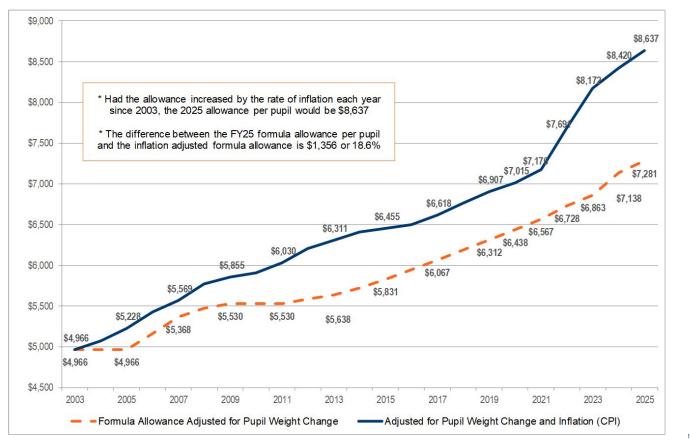

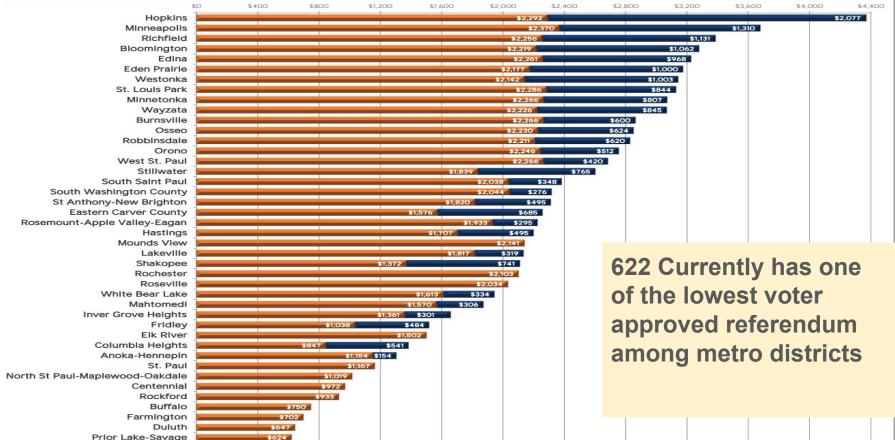
Likely Budget Shortfall for FY 26
