**BOARD GOAL:** Academic Excellence

FISCAL NOTE: None

## **Background Information:**

- Last summer, over 400 Pre-kindergarten through 4<sup>th</sup> grade and Limited English Speaking elementary students attended the district summer school.
- Last summer, over 575 secondary students attended summer school (50 were students from other districts)
- Elementary School Curriculum-reading improvement, early literacy skills, math concepts and applications, language acquisition and English proficiencies for LEP students
- Secondary School Course Offerings 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grades-math, science, language arts, social studies. Additionally, health and keyboarding are offered to students entering 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Classes are held at Central High School.
- Secondary School Course Offerings 9<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> geometry, biology, physics and chemistry, English, world geography, American history, world history, government, economics, health, business communications, agriculture, and communications applications

### **Administrative Considerations:**

### **ELEMENTARY**

- Offerings for elementary summer school will focus on Pre-Kindergarten Kindergarten Limited English Speaking Students, accelerated instruction for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders who failed reading TAKS and 5<sup>th</sup> graders who failed math TAKS.
- Other elementary students may qualify to attend summer school based on failure on one or more portions of the 2005 TAKS, failing grades in math and/or language arts, failure to make progress in the Accelerated Reading/Math Programs, limited skills as identified in the Texas Primary Reading Inventory, and LEP students identified in grades 1-6.
- Some identified students receiving Special Education services will be recommended for the six-week ESY Program.

 Summer School is funded from state and federal funds. In addition, bus transportation will be provided.

#### **SECONDARY**

- Offerings for secondary students will be the same for this summer.
- The secondary summer school is funded through fees:

Grades 9-12 \$25 non-refundable deposit \$175 tuition per ½ credit class Out of District Students-\$200 per ½ credit class

Grades 7-8 \$25 non-refundable deposit \$175 per course Out of District Students-\$200 per course
