- All of our Fall Sports teams have completed their Regular Seasons and are into the Postseason portion of their Schedules.

Athletics Updates**Tennis**

- It was a productive season for the Ranger Tennis team! Tori Oehrlein won the Section 7A singles Championship for the second consecutive season becoming the first singles player to make back-to-back State Tournaments in Ranger Tennis History. She enters State as the #4 Seed with a 25-3 overall record on the season and recorded her 100th Career Victory during the season. Three players received All-Conference honors for their play in the Granite Ridge Conference, Tori Oehrlein & Emma Silgen were named to the All-Conference Team while Nellie Fitzpatrick was named Honorable Mention.

Volleyball

- Volleyball finished the regular season 18-5 overall and were 9-0 in Great River Conference play clinching the Great River Conference Championship. It is the first Conference Title for the Volleyball program since 1996! They start their Postseason 10/24 as the #1 seed on their side of the bracket and will host a QuarterFinal matchup. They will most certainly have a few players receive All-Conference honors but those awards have not been announced yet.

Football

- After finishing the Regular Season 2-6 the Ranger Football team travels to International Falls for the Section 7AA QuarterFinals on 10/21. During the season Keyon Wesnar threw for 965 yards and 12 TD passes with 4 of those going to Jeremy Henson. Kaleb Billman led the team with 58 tackles while Julian Lange & Ethan Anderson both added 46 tackles. Coach Syrstad graduates fourteen Seniors but looks forward to the future with big numbers at lower levels.

Cross Country

- The Cross Country team is preparing for the Section 7A Championships on 10/23. The Girls team won the Great River Conference Championship securing their first Conference title since 1984. They placed 5 runners in the top 7 finishers and six secured All-Conference honors (Sophia Hanson, Maddie Lacerte, Lia Stokman, Aubree Babler, McKenna Severson, Scarlett Katzenberger) and one Honorable Mention (Greta Lang). The Boys finished 4th place as a team with Peter Bartels and Justin Reisz being named to the All-Conference team. Head Coach Erica Perpich was named the Great River Conference Girls Coach of the Year.
