District Goal: #1 Pursuit of Instructional Excellence

Critical Element: Use the PSD Instructional Framework, grade level created Scope and Sequence, and the MTSS process to improve instructional practices and student growth.

Specific Goal: All students will make grade level academic growth in math and reading. Staff will collect and monitor student progress through the use of assessment.

Current Status: Students come to kindergarten with varying academic academic abilities. The PELC will focus on all students being on grade level in reading and math. Students will all be provided with Tier 1 instruction, and those identified as needing additional support (through the MTSS process) will receive additional targeted, explicit instruction.
