The Texas Education Agency (TEA) has notified the district that improvement is needed in our practices regarding placement in Out of School Suspension (OSS) for unallowable reasons affecting students in specific grade levels (k-2) as well as students who are identified as homeless. After reviewing our data, TEA has issued a corrective action plan which must be approved by the school board and signed to indicate our district's commitment to implement improvements.

District leadership has developed a local response protocol to ensure that we will be able to meet all expectations of corrective action plan #SRDR2025-11-10.

McKinney ISD will complete the following steps to ensure compliance:

- Provide training to all staff on identification of students experiencing homelessness
- Provide specialized training to administrative staff that will be responsible for assigning discipline
- Provide specialized training to counselors to support students experiencing homelessness
- Implement changes to our current Out of School Suspension (OSS0) procedures
- Implement new monitoring protocols at both the district and the campus level to ensure compliance with our updated procedures
- Implement progressive interventions with our staff if there are any future violations of the updated procedure
- Research technological solutions that will help to deter future mistakes in data entry and reporting

Through these steps, the district will improve our discipline responses and maximize the time that students are spending in the regular instructional environment.

Impact Statement: Approval of this corrective action plan is necessary to meet our compliance obligations under state law and will support the success of our students.
