I. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- A. VCSF Annual Report Warren Lawrence: Mr. Lawrence presented the 2010-2011 VCSF Annual Report including increased scholarships, Curiosity Grants and Bardeen Grants. It was a great year for finances with \$77,000 in gifts and distributions of \$35,000 in grants. Mr. Lawrence gave a big thanks to Amy Manchester and Tonya Nash for their continued support in making the VCSF a success.
- B. Recognition of Unsung Heroes: Al Reynolds and Brad Russell: Transportation Director Ric Beers congratulated Al Reynolds and Brad Russell for receiving the Unsung Hero Awards.
- C. <u>Important Dates:</u> Supt. Glaes invited the Board and audience to the Vicksburg Community Tailgate Celebration.
- D. <u>Preliminary Enrollment Figures:</u> The preliminary count show enrollment at 2504. This is down significantly from September, 2010. Supt. Glaes requested the addition of a section at 2nd grade at Sunset Lake due to high numbers in that grade level.
- E. Report on Opening Preservice Activities and Ceremonies: Building Principals described their opening preservice days. Professional staff attended a session with other Kalamazoo County districts at Portage Central High School to hear speaker Charlie Colemen on the last day.
- F. <u>Reproductive Health Program Parent Notification for 2011-12:</u> Supt. Glaes stated that the letter is our annual parent notification.
- G. <u>Legislative Update:</u> Supt. Glaes reviewed the latest legislative action. Asst. Supt. Goss discussed SB7 and presented a Power Point describing the history of district health care costs.

- B. <u>Professional Development Report:</u> Supt. Glaes reported that a number of teachers and administrators joined our staff for professional development. In addition Pat Wilson O'Leary has been working with Mary Burk on Cooperative Learning, Ruth Hook on Mentors, and Stephanie Mallery on Academic Coaches training them to take over as leaders. Mrs. O'Leary has been working with Principals on the new evaluation process for next year.
- C. Athletic Department Report Mike Roy: Mr. Roy presented the 2010-2011 Annual

Report which included student, district, and coaching awards and achievements.

D. <u>Audience:</u> Lisa Johnson addressed the Board about family athletic passes. Mr. Roy explained the background of student passes and punch passes.

Brad Geesaman thanked the Board and Administration for their collaborative work on the contract.
